



Dance Etiquette & Studio Safety Policy

Introduction

This policy has been written in conjunction with YDAs Health and safety policy, premises management policy, behavior policy, uniform policy, first aid policy and appropriate physical correction policy.

Uniform/Presentation

- All students must wear the school vocational uniform in all their vocational lessons.
- Dance shoes and uniform must be clean and presentable.
- Once warmups are taken off, they should be hung on the pegs provided in the changing room or placed in the allocated spots in the studio.
- Students must not place their clothing or water bottles by fire exits or doorways.
- Students must not dance in socks or tights.

In the Studio

- Students must allow the teacher and pianist (if they are playing at the beginning of the class) to enter the studio first.
- Students are only allowed into a studio with the permission of the class teacher or assistant.
- At the end of the class students are expected to thank the teachers and the pianist.

Accidents

- If an accident happens in the dance studio the teacher will stay with the person and send a student to get the first aider.
- As stated in the First Aid Policy, all accidents will be logged by the first aider and the parent / guardian notified.

Fire Alarm

- If the fire alarm sounds, all students and staff are to exit through the nearest fire exit without collecting their belongings.
- Students are to follow the instructions given by the member of staff in charge.
